- Load luggage and instruments.....10:00 a.m.
- Put luggage on sidewalk in area where buses will park. Luggage will go on the bus that you are assigned to ride. (Refer to luggage limit and information below.)
 - Take your carry-on into the band hall and put by your chair.
 - Put your band instrument on ground behind the Band equipment truck.
 - Next, check out your uniform and check your uniform bag for jacket, white trousers, 2 citation cords, white socks and white band shoes. Please be sure your shoes are polished.
 - Then, take your uniform to the Band equipment truck to be loaded on the truck, not the bus.
 - Place your “box dinner” in the coolers marked for this purpose. We will stop at a roadside park for our first meal. Everyone must bring a “box dinner” with them. The band boosters will furnish the drinks.
 - Finally, be seated in the band hall.

- Leave for Florida.....11:30 a.m.
- We will stop for fuel, meals and driver changes.

BEHAVIOR: All school policies and procedures; and instructions by the band director will be followed at all times. Students who do not follow the rules will be sent home immediately at your parents' expense.

WHAT TO WEAR: Have your band shirts and trip shirts with you. Wear your band T-shirt under your uniform for the parade. You will wear your military uniform for the parade. **Don't forget your band shoes and white socks.** Don't forget swim wear and appropriate dress for Disney World. Sunscreen is a must on this trip. Look at our schedule and pack accordingly for each event.

JEWELRY: Please do not bring expensive jewelry on this trip. In addition, the Panther Band policy has always been that you do not wear jewelry while in uniform. The Disney entertainment department called and advised me of their "no jewelry policy". Please do not delay our getting ready for performance by having me waste time removing your jewelry.

EQUIPMENT: Don't forget your band instrument, music flip folder, extra reeds, valve oil, slide oil, drum sticks, mallets, percussion equipment, etc. The loading crew will load equipment, but it still your responsibility to put your instrument in the proper place to be loaded and check to see if it was loaded.

LUGGAGE: Please limit your luggage to: one suitcase (that you can carry), one hanging bag (only if needed), uniform in bag, one carry on, and your band instrument.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: If you bring audio/video devices, you must use headphones only with these items; Unauthorized items will be confiscated by the director. Listen carefully during all meetings for more special instructions.
