

Bullard Intermediate Grading Policy

2021-2022 School Year

Number of Grades/Percentage

- 6th Grade: 8-10 Daily Grades (Minimum) 60% of total grade
- 6th Grade: 2 Test Grades (Minimum) 40% of total grade
- 5th Grade: 8-10 Daily Grades and 2 Test Grades (Minimum & not weighted)

Late Work

- One day late results in -10 points
- 2-5 days late-Highest grade of 70%
- 5 plus days late-ZAP and highest grade of 70%
 - ZAP work is due the following Monday. Students earn a grade of zero if work is not turned in.
 - Students can correct assignments that are below a 70 for up to 70 (daily and tests).

Make-Up Work

- Students are given one day for each day they were absent to complete make up work. (2 days absent=2 days to make up work).

Mastery Learning Policy

Learning for mastery is a goal at Bullard Intermediate. Therefore, students will be given multiple opportunities to display mastery of skills and content. Some examples of mastery learning include revision of assignments and test corrections. Students will need to complete revisions and corrections at the discretion of the teacher. Mastery Learning policies are consistent with both grade levels.
